New Electronics Recycling rules at Eagle Enterprises Recycling, Inc. Effective Jan. 1, 2019

For Electronics coming from an individual residence.

- All Covered Electronic Devices (CEDs) are accepted. CEDs are listed in the Consumer Electronics Recycling Act and include:
 - o Televisions (CRT, Projection, and Flat Panel)
 - Computer Monitors (CRT and Flat Panel)
 - o Computers (including desktop, laptop, netbook, notebook, and tablet)
 - Cable Receivers
 - Satellite Receivers
 - Digital Converter Boxes
 - o DVD Players and Recorders
 - o Printer
 - Electronic Keyboard (for a computer)
 - Fax Machines
 - o VCRs
 - Portable Digital Music Players (that has memory capability and is battery powered)
 - Video Game Consoles
 - o Electronic Mouse (for a computer)
 - Scanners
 - Small Scale Servers (sold at retail)
- There is a charge of \$5.00 for all televisions and computer monitors up to 27 inches (measured diagonally across the visible screen); \$10.00 for televisions and monitors larger than 27 inches; and \$20.00 for all rear projection televisions.
- Certain other electronics are acceptable including:
 - Microwaves
 - o Christmas Lights
 - Cell Phones
 - o Rechargeable Batteries
- Any other electronic device not listed above can be accepted, for a charge of \$0.35 per pound.
- Leaving electronics outside of regular business hours outside of the business or at the drop off will be treated as illegal dumping and reported to law enforcement for prosecution.
